Description of the organisation

With more than 700 years of history, more than 113,000 students, 3,300 faculty and 2,000 staff, technicians and librarians, as well as 1,800 administrative staff of university hospitals, Sapienza is the leading university in Europe. Our mission is to contribute to the development of a knowledge society through research, excellence, quality education and international cooperation.

The world's top university rankings place Sapienza at the top of Italian universities in terms of research quality, education and international dimension; in addition, Sapienza excels and excels as a benchmark in many subject areas.

Sapienza currently offers more than 280 bachelor's (Bachelor's and Master's) degree programs - more than 35 of which are taught in English - 200 professional master's degrees and nearly 80 PhDs. The School of Advanced Studies offers a program of excellence and free tuition for top students. Students with an Italian high school score of 100 are exempt from tuition fees, and the bonus is extended if they maintain good grades. Families with multiple children enrolled in the university also enjoy a special sibling bonus.

The University's services include 54 libraries (four with 24-hour reading rooms), 18 museums, the Ciao and Hello guidance offices, a guidance and mentoring office in each faculty, a Disabled Students Office, the Job Soul Placement office and a Public Relations Office. La Sapienza University also promotes a wide range of cultural, social and sports activities and has several facilities (over 100,000 square meters) for sports, music and theater, as well as RadioSapienza web radio.

More than 30,000 students come from other Italian cities, nearly 9,000 foreigners and more than 3,500 students a year come to Sapienza for international mobility programs. Thanks to an extensive network of agreements with universities around the world, Sapienza also offers its students numerous international opportunities, including double degrees, study abroad scholarships, internships in European and non-European countries and international PhDs.

Scientific research activity at Sapienza covers an extremely broad spectrum of disciplines, achieving levels of excellence in many areas, including archaeology, physics and astrophysics, humanities and cultural heritage, environment, nanotechnology, cell and gene therapy, design, aerospace, social and economic sciences. Nobel Prize winners and internationally renowned scientists have taught and/or studied at Sapienza.

Sapienza is organized into 11 faculties, a School of Advanced Studies, a Graduate School of Aerospace Engineering, 58 departments, as well as numerous research and service centers. The central administration is organized into areas, offices and sectors.

The rectorate is collegial with a chancellor, a deputy director and a group of deputy directors and delegates with specific responsibilities, alongside committees and commissions for evaluation, strategic planning, quality and integration of activities, as well as for specific issues.
