Experience and Expertise of the organization in the project's subject area

In addition to 35 years of experience in training professionals in Education, Psychology, Administration and Accounting, the Universidad Marcelino Champagnat has continuously carried out training activities for teachers from different regions of the country, in agreement with state entities, such as the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Culture, municipalities and local educational units.

The University has trained teachers in topics related to the advances of new technologies and their impact on educational and social development, thus, for example, the Tutoring Service was provided in virtual mode with the aim of strengthening digital competence in teachers and pedagogical coordinators from 375 educational institutions, organized by the Ministry of Education. It was selected by the Ministry of Culture to provide the course "Strengthening political and leadership rights in indigenous and native Afro-Peruvian youth, virtual modality" and by the Ministry of Economy and Finance to provide the service of developing massive online open courses on government and digital transformation.

Likewise, its educational projection extends to the most vulnerable areas of the country, for example, with the project "A teacher for the Datem" it has provided professional training to young people from indigenous communities of the Peruvian Amazon: Shavi, Kandozi, Achuar, Kichwa, Chapra, Awajun, Wampis.

These are some projects in which the University participates, providing training to teachers and leaders from different communities in Peru on topics related to the impact of new technologies.

In all training activities the ethical response of each member of the community is always the starting point and horizon.

Contributions that can be provided to the project

The participation of the Universidad Marcelino Champagnat in this project will have a significant impact at the local, regional, national and international level, which is made possible through its links with the local government (Municipality of Santiago de Surco), with the Regional Directorate of Education of Metropolitan Lima, with the Ministry of Education and different Local Educational Management Units of Peru, with the educational works of the Congregation of Marist Brothers of the Province of Santa María de los Andes (Peru, Bolivia and Chile) and with the Network Marist International of Higher Education.

The University is committed not only to the initial training of teachers, but also to the training of in-service teachers throughout the national territory. The pedagogical development that is taking place at the university is projected towards basic education teachers through the training carried out in conjunction with the Ministry of Education, Local Management Educational Units, the Municipality and different civil society organizations. Therefore, these education professionals will benefit from the different products obtained in the execution of the project and so will their students and, through them, their families.
